



CNMC Produced A Record 5,201.28 Ounces of Gold Doré Bars In The Month of September 2014

All capitalised terms used in this announcement shall, unless otherwise defined herein, have the meaning ascribed to them in the Company's announcement dated 9 July 2014 in relation to the highest record for monthly output since the start of gold production ("Announcement").

The board of directors (the "Board") of CNMC Goldmine Holdings Limited ("CNMC" or the "Company") is delighted to report that the Company's Sokor Gold Project produced 5,201.28 ounces of gold doré bars¹ in the month of September 2014, which is the highest record to date for monthly output since the start of gold production in July 2010.

This surpasses its previous record of 4,356.47 ounces as reported in the Announcement, representing an increase of approximately 19.4%.
