



SOKOR GOLD PROJECT PRODUCED 8,750.27 OUNCES OF GOLD DORÉ BARS¹ IN 2Q2018

The board of directors (the “**Board**”) of CNMC Goldmine Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”) is pleased to announce that with the Company’s carbon-in-leach (“**CIL**”) plant in full commercial operation since 2 May 2018, the Company’s flagship Sokor gold mine in Malaysia’s Kelantan state produced a total of 8,750.27 ounces of gold doré bars¹ in the second quarter of 2018.

With the CIL plant now in stable operation, the Company’s focus is to identify opportunities to further optimise operating parameters with the view to increasing gold output and bringing down costs.
